## **Government Announcement**

Many of you will have tuned in to the Prime Minister's speech last night. I am sure you will have questions and some concerns about what he said in relation to schools reopening. Unfortunately, as we only heard the information at the same time as you, we do not yet have any answers. We will be waiting for further guidance and clarification from the government and once we have any details or information, I will share it with you.

Please can I reinforce that, currently, we continue to only offer childcare to the children of critical workers (as defined in the list on 5<sup>th</sup> May) and to our vulnerable children. I understand that this makes returning to work difficult for some families, however these measures were put in place nationally to ensure the safety of our community and to try and slow the spreading of COVID-19. Thank you for your support and understanding in this matter.

### Thank you

Whilst school remains closed to the vast majority of our children, staff are in school each week on a rota providing care for some of our vulnerable children and the children of critical workers. One of our local shops, *Mr Convenience*, has generously been donating treats for these children every Friday – a real act of community support and care. I will be writing a formal thank you letter to the store for their kindness towards our staff and children at this difficult time.
