

Key Instant Recall Facts

Year 1 – Autumn 2

Count in 10s to 100, forwards and backwards Add 2 to a given number.

By the end of this half term, children should know the following facts. The aim is for them to recall these facts **instantly**.

Children should be able to count in steps of 10 from any multiple of 10, forwards	0 + 2 = 2 I + 2 = 3	Key Vocabulary Steps of 10
and backwards, to 100.	2 + 2 = 4	Ten more
	3 + 2 = 5	Forwards

Top Tips
