#### Do you have a child 18 months and over?

Your local Children's Centres are providing Wellcomm language screenings.

Wellcomm is a Sandwell programme which we use between 18 months and 3 years to make sure a child's communication is progressing as it should. It is a short screening done by play, everyday interactions and looking at pictures. We feel by identifying a communication need early and providing that intervention before they go to school is most beneficial.







Solihull Approach is a 10 week programme which aims to help parents to understand their child's development, communication and emotional needs UNDERSTANDING YOUR CHILD


Suitable for families with children 0-18 years

Support can be provided to families on a 1-1 basis helping you to deal with an array of issues such as routines, boundaries and behaviours. Support is for families with children aged 0-19 years old (25 years if SEND). For us to be able to support you and offer the right type support, when you contact we will take some further information to complete a referral form. This will allow us to sign post you in the right direction and allocate a worker to support you and your family.





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### **Working Together With Families**

Working Together with Families is a new Action for Children service offering 22 weeks of intensive support to families for early intervention where there are concerns about neglect.

The programme is for single agency/early help cases where there has been no previous involvement at CIN and CP level. The service covers all 4 towns – West Bromwich, Smethwick, Wednesbury, and Oldbury. The types of support provided is hands on practical support with improving home conditions, putting routines in place to help with getting to school on time, hand holding to appointments for the children and parents.

We use the Graded Care Profile 2 as a tool to further assess the situation which is completed with the family and action plans are put in place to work out the support needed and how that will be achieved.
