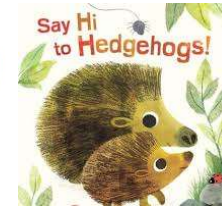
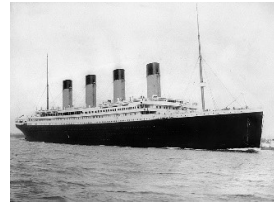


Spring Term Year 2

English

Our English journey this term focuses on the children writing to inform and to entertain! We will be linking with our work in Science lessons as well as learning about fairy tales.

We will continue this term with focusing on the basics of writing in Year 2 but will be applying new skills on top of this. Children will be applying difference sentence types as well as punctuation to their sentences to support with cohesion. We want our children to have a positive attitude and stamina for writing so during this term we will work towards the children writing a fact file about an animal of their choice as well as a twisted tale!



Science

This term, the children will continue to explore and compare the difference in living things. We will continue to identify safe habitats for different living things. We will begin to investigate animals around the world, how they are adapted to live in different continents and create a model habitat.

Maths

In our Spring term, we will finish our work on money, finding change and adding amounts to make a total. Next, we will introduce multiplication and division, learning how to create arrays, use repeated addition and count in 2s, 5s and 10s to solve arithmetic and worded problems. Once we are confident with our 2s, 5s and 10s, pupils will move on to looking at scales counting in these amounts. They will learn different units of measure and begin to measure distances, weights, capacity and temperature.

History

Children will develop an awareness of the past and how it is represented. They will begin to discover and learn about the event of the Titanic sinking. Their job will be to work out what happened, who might be to blame and what we can do to make sure this disaster is not repeated again.

Computing

Children will use technology to create algorithms. They will also work on their data handling skills within technology.

Art

Children will be developing their knowledge on painting. The year group show they can identify different textures and describe the colours and textures that they can see.

PSHE

We will cover our Dreams and Goals as well as learning how to become a healthy version of ourselves.

Geography

This term we will be using globes and atlases to identify the world's hot and cold regions. During the lessons we will be looking at simple maps and aerial views of a contrasting locality and identifying the similarities and differences. We will also be linking this to our science unit and looking at how the animals are adapted to live in these environments.

P.E.

Children will explore strategies for Throwing and catching with a focus on ball skills. Children will throw a ball at the right speed and height as well as be able to find different ways to twist and turn to catch the ball.

Design and Technology

During this unit, the children will begin to sketch and model make, before finally building a strong, sturdy structure and evaluating it.

R.E.

Children will learn about Holy places, more specifically focusing on where Sikhs worship. Towards Spring 2 we will be focusing on Easter!

Music

Children will work on the Keyboards working whole class. There will be a focus on vocabulary including pitch, tempo and dynamics as well as performing in front of their peers.
