1b. ii) They are rigid; they do not bend	KU	1	Accept any one answer for 1 mark Accept they are tough or strong
2a. Metal, plastic, wood	A/WS	1	Two or three correct for 1 mark
2b. i) metal, wood	A/WS	2	1 mark for each correct material
2b. ii) Any reference made to suitable physical properties, e.g. rigidity; strength; waterproofness	A/WS	1	Accept the food would not get squashed
3a. It is light; it won't hurt if it hits you; you can kick/throw it a long way; you can wash it if it gets dirty; it is cheap	KU	1	Accept any one answer for 1 mark
3b. Squash it; push it; pull it; twist it; put something heavy on it	A	1	Accept any one answer for 1 mark
