Weekly Writing and Grammar Tasks	Weekly Maths Tasks
This week we'd like to focus our tasks on the story of Little Red Riding Hood. We have uploaded the story on a PowerPoint. Please refer to 'Writing Week 5.' <u>Task 1 – Read the story and talk about</u> your favourite parts and characters. <u>Task 2 – Draw the main parts of the</u> story. <u>Task 3 – Think about the people that</u>	 <u>Task 1</u> – Children to have a go at doubling numbers. They should have a go at using real objects to help them double a number and try to write it as an addition number sentence. <u>Task 2</u> – Today children will have a go at making equal groups by grouping objects. Use real objects if possible and talk about the word equal. <u>Task 3</u> – Here we will continue with grouping but this time we will do it by sharing. Talk about this word and what it means. When we share something, it is equal. Use things like
you are missing and what presents of treats you'd take them to make them happy if you could. <u>Task 4 –</u> Plan a text message to send to a loved one using the format and	sweets/crayons and practice sharing equally between teddies for example. <u>Task 4</u> – Knowing about the word equal will help children to find a half. Talk about the word half and what this could mean. How can we cut a piece of paper in half? Try doing this
