Al Akhir (الأخر)

The Last

Al Quddus (القدوس) The Most Holy

Al Muhyi (المحيى)
The Giver of Life

Al Majid (المجيد) The All Glorious

Al Mumit (المميت)
The Bringer of Death

Al Hakim (الحكيم)
The Wise



Al Wali (الولى)
The Protecting Friend

Al Rashid (الرشيد) The Guide to the right path

Al Sami' (السميع)
The All Hearing

Al Salam (السلام)
The source of peace

## The Subha (prayer beads)

- Muslim have 99 names to describe Allah.
- To help them remember all the names Muslims may use a Subha when praying
- These beads are counted one by one and a name of Allah is recited.



## Making our own Subha

- Try to make your own Subha. This could be made to remember how you would describe someone important to you.
- You will need to thread beads on a string, but you can also include words that describe an important person or people that mean a lot to you.
