Dear Parents and Carers

## Year 6 children in school next week

Next week, Year 6 have their second transition day at school. This is on the same day as it was last week (e.g. if your child came in on Tuesday this week then they come into school on Tuesday next week).

- As it is their last day at Uplands Manor, we have arranged a picnic for Year 6 on the days that they are in school – this is being paid for by school and the children will not need to bring in a packed lunch.

## Plans for September

We have finalised our return to school plan that enables us to welcome back all of our children in September.

I am currently writing a document for parents to inform you about the measures that will be in place and the systems and procedures that you will need to follow. This will be sent to you at the start of next week. Please read it carefully and make note of the key points that you will need to know in September.

A few parents have called me to ask about arrangements for September. Please wait for and read the guidance next week – I am confident that it will reassure you that we have considered all measures in line with current government guidance. Please understand that I cannot get into hundreds of individual conversations with parents at this stage.

## Items left in school

In march, school closed to most pupils quite suddenly and, as a result, lots of children left personal items in school such as PE kits, coats, stationary etc. All items are being passed to the new class teachers to give out when we return in September. We are not getting rid of anything or sending it to lost property at this stage.

This is really kind and gifts are always very much appreciated. **Please can I ask that you hold onto any gifts and send them into school with your child in September** to avoid us having lots of extra adults and items coming into school as it puts everyone at an increased risk. #### Free school meal (FSM) vouchers – summer holiday

We emailed you last week to confirm that the government are issuing FSM vouchers over the summer holiday to eligible families. We are issuing the vouchers on the following dates throughout the summer:

- To reach your email by Friday 10/7/20 £15 voucher per child to cover the week beginning 20/7/20. This is early but we had to use this date due to the system.
- To reach your email by Friday 24/7/20 £30 voucher per child to cover the weeks beginning 27/7/20 and 03/8/20.
- To reach your email by Friday 7/8/20 £30 voucher per child to cover the weeks beginning 10/8/20 and 17/8/20.
- To reach your email by Friday 14/8/20- £15 voucher per child to cover the week beginning 24/8/20.

Given the restrictions that are still in place (and will still be in September) we cannot have groups of parents coming into school and so **these meetings have been cancelled.** We are currently looking for alternative ways that this can be done (for example virtual meetings, pre-recorded messages by the staff) and will let you know what we have decided when we return in September. #### Full school closure over the summer holiday

School has been open every day (including bank holidays) to the children of key workers since schools were forced to close back in March. We will not be open to any children over the summer but look forward to welcoming all children back to school in September.

Please note:

- Children in Years 1 to 6 will return to school on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> September as planned.
- Reception and Nursery children will have their usual phased starts at school as per the letters sent home to parents.
