# Note for parents

In geography our new topic is all about India this term. Using the PowerPoint (slides 3 and 4) show your child where India is on the map. Then discuss with your child its shape (on the map India is the shape of an elephant's ear) and location (India is part of Asia and is near Russia and China. India has sea/ocean on the left and right of it). Children then to complete task one locating India on two maps (map 1 and map 2) and then label India on their own map (map 3). For task 2 recap the PowerPoint with your child. Children then to answer true or false to the statements.
