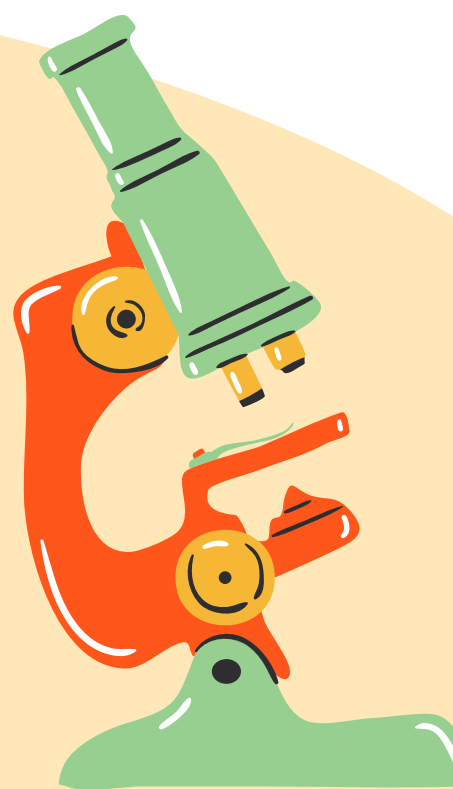
SCIENCE WEEK POSTER COMPETITION

Can you create a new invention to improve the health of the air in our buildings?

Entries must be handed into school by **Monday 24th March.**



Choose an indoor public space where you often spend time - it could be an area where you learn or a place you visit regularly like a library, café or cinema.

Come up with an idea or invention to change the air in your chosen space to make it healthier to breathe. How will it work? Could it be used in other public places?

You can come up with a new idea or a new way of using something that already exists. Some examples are face masks, screens, ventilation - use your imagination

Think about the science behind your idea. How will it work? How will it be made and used?

Your design must be A4 or A3 in size. You can create a poster, a diagram, a graph or a set of instructions. Whatever you create must be able to be photographed.

Photographs of the winning posters will be taken and sent into the national competition.
