## Dear Parents and Carers

Here is the newsletter for next half term. Please read the contents carefully and share them with other parents so that everyone is up to date about what is happening in school and of key messages and reminders.

<u>Please remember</u> - most communication from school will be via email and the School Gateway app. Please ensure you have the app downloaded with push messages switched to 'on.' It is vital that you are using the app for school messages, and that we also have an up to date email address for you as well.

## Term Time Holiday and Leave of Absence Requests

Please be aware that Holidays and leaves of absence to travel abroad in term time will not be authorised by school. Holidays and visiting family <u>must</u> be booked during the school holiday periods. Penalty notices (fines) will be issued whenever possible if holidays are taken – over 50 were issued to parents at our school last year.

Before any travelling is booked, a leave of absence request form <u>must</u> be submitted to the attendance team using our official form. Please expect all travel to be unauthorised unless in the most exceptional of circumstances, and for fixed penalty notices to be issued at £60 per parent per child.

# PE days for the start of the summer term and PE kit reminder

A PE letter has been sent by email to all families, informing you of the PE days for each class next half term. Children should come into school wearing their PE kit on their PE days (as outlined above).

• Reception children should come into school in usual uniform and leave their PE kits in school as getting changed is part of their early years' curriculum.

<u>Reminder:</u> Children <u>must not</u> wear football kits, designer t-shirts, colourful non-uniform jumper and clothes etc. **They must wear plain black shorts and a plain white t-shirt or polo top, and their red school jumper or cardigan.** Plain dark tracksuit trousers can be worn in colder weather.

Standards have slipped in relation to PE kit in school, and staff have been asked to challenge this and issue green letters where incorrect PE kit is being worn. Please support us with improving this and having high expectations of our children at all times.

### Uniform Expectations

Please ensure your child is wearing the correct school uniform every day. Children <u>should not</u> be wearing white, coloured or designer trainers, tracksuit bottoms, or jewellery such as dangling earrings, chains or necklaces or bracelets,

### FSM vouchers over the Easter Holiday

Sandwell are providing free school meal vouchers again over half term to all children who receive benefit-related free school meals and those who have no recourse to public funds. These are being sent out this week, but are now at a reduced rate of £15 in total per child, not per week.

This <u>is not</u> the same as universal infant free school meals for Reception, Year 1 and Year 2. Only children in these year groups who are eligible for free school meals will be included.

If you think you may be eligible, but are not currently receiving free school meals, please speak with the office who can assist you.

#### Reminder - Birthdays

Reminder – on your child's birthday (or the nearest school day if it is at a weekend or in holiday time), they can come into school wearing non-uniform so that they feel special and everyone who sees them can wish them a happy birthday.

Please <u>do not</u> send in cake, sweets or other food. We have a number of allergies and dietary requirements in school and updated our 'food in school' policy a few years ago to ask you not to send food into school to share. Thank you for your support and understanding with this.

### RHSE (Relationships, Health and Sex Education) next term

In June, we will be covering the 'Changing Me' units as part of our PSHE (including RHSE) curriculum. So that parents and carers are aware of what content will be covered in key stage 2, meetings have been planned for you to attend and hear about our provision, view any resources and ask questions. Meeting dates are:

- Year 6 24<sup>th</sup> April at 9am

Meetings will be being led by Mr Flavell in our school hall. Parents are to wait on the main playground at the start of the day, and will be brought into school once we have welcomed in all of our children.

### Parent Governor Vacancy

We currently have a vacancy for a new parent governor at our school. This is an important and valued role and we are looking for a committed parent or carer to join our governors and help lead our school into the future.

#### SENCO Role

Mrs Flavell is due to go on maternity leave at the end of April. I am delighted to announce that Miss Begum has been appointed to cover her maternity leave, and will be teaching in 2F for the remainder of this school year. 2F's teaching assistants will remain the same and are not changing.

She is a strong teacher who has been carrying out a really good job in 5H, and I am thankful that she is able to help us provide consistency and a high-quality education to the children in this class.
