As we move into the half term holidays, it gives me an opportunity to update you with what we have been working on in school this half term.

Children have settled back into school well and we have noticed very smart and well behaved individuals through school. Thank you to parents for ensuring your child has the correct uniform. We have our nearly new rail in the main entrance for any spare uniform that you may need. ## Work we have been doing this term includes:

- All staff have had speech and language training from our specialists at the local authority. We do an

- We have a new Chair of Governors Mark Tyson.
- Our whole school attendance continues to improve and we are in line with our target of 96% thank you to parents for working with us to achieve this we have to keep it up as this makes a
  huge difference to what your children will achieve at the end of Y6 and into secondary school.
- We have appointed our new House Captains from Y6 for this year they represent their house teams. They had to complete an application form and have an interview with me and Mrs Monk they did a super job.

- We are spending lots of money on revamping and refurbishing our school library children visit
