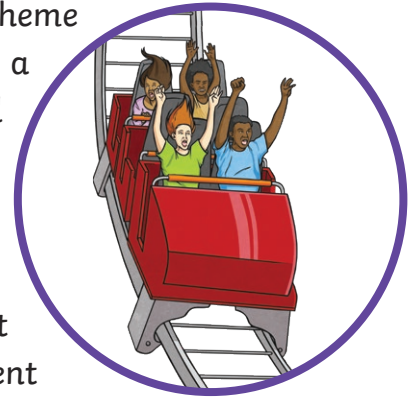


# The Roller Coaster
