



Learning Project Week beginning 18.5.2020

Year Group: Year 6

Daily tasks

Reading:

- Children to read to parents daily. This can be a variety of things e.g. fiction, non-fiction, magazines, online articles
- Ask your child to read a chapter from their home reading book or a book that they have borrowed from the library. Can they note down any exciting words and use them in a sentence?

Maths:

- Play on TT Rockstars – Can they improve their score by the end of the week?
- Practice arithmetic for different areas of maths. Your child should aim to work on timing themselves to solve 30 arithmetic questions in 40 minutes. There are 3 papers for them to try.

Handwriting:

- Ask your child to write a review of a film they have watched. Can they describe what happened in the film? Who were the characters? Would they recommend the film? Weekly Maths Tasks

Working on [Times Table Rockstars](#). The same login as usual. Get in touch if you need your log in details.

What do they know about shape. Ask your child to tell you what they already know about 2D and 3D shapes. Can they find examples around the home or when out for a walk? They could take photos of the shapes and label the properties of the shape on the picture. **Please upload examples to @UplandsManor Twitter page or to their teachers @MissSedge @Goodall_Miss @RoddissMiss @templeton_mr**

To help them to label the properties of the shape there is a video in Home Learning – Maths videos which will explain about 3D shapes.

Ask your child to work on their reasoning and problem solving by practising past SATs questions.

Ask your child to read a chapter from the book they are reading at the moment.

Once they have read a chapter, ask your child to choose a descriptive scene from the book. Can they use what they read in the book to draw what they think it will look like? Where it is set? Which characters are there?

You could even make your own dinosaur and dinosaur scene and try some stop motion animation!

National Smile Month

National Smile Month begins this week. This is the start of a month which focuses on teeth. Your challenge is to find everything you can about teeth. How many teeth do we have? What are their different purposes? What is the difference between human and animal teeth? Why? You can present your findings how you would like: using iPad, tablet, PowerPoint, poster or through a film.

You could also create something to teach younger children the importance of looking after your teeth and how to do it. Your teachers will really love to see what you are creating for this.



Thursday 21st May – Outdoor Classroom

The weather is looking good for Thursday so spend some time outside away from the computer and books. Take the learning outside for a while. You could go for a walk with your family or sit in the garden for a while. Use your senses: what can you hear, smell, see and feel? Create a poem about it, draw a picture or find out about the different plants and birds that you see. Maybe you could build a den and spend some time relaxing, reading your favourite

book. Create a piece of art using only the things you can find while you are outside, don't forget to take a picture of it and share it with your teachers.
