#### School Update

Since mid-March, school has remained open every day (including Bank Holidays) to provide childcare for some of our vulnerable children and the children of Key Workers. It has been a pleasure to have these children in school each week and to do our part as a school to support parents working in key roles during this pandemic and I would like to thank my staff for their hard work and support in making this possible.

- On Monday, we welcomed back some of our Reception children and it has been wonderful to see them running into school smiling and enjoying being back at school.
- On Monday 29<sup>th</sup> June, some of our Year 1 children are returning to school and we are really looking forward to seeing them again.
- From Monday 6<sup>th</sup> June some of our Year 6 children will be coming back to school for some transition work and to say goodbye to their teachers and friends.

Any parents in Reception, Year 1 or Year 6 requesting a place for their child to return to school must give a minimum of 1 weeks' notice. This also applies to key workers who need to email <u>keyworkers@uplandsmanor.sandwell.sch.uk</u> to request a place for their child.

# What will happen in September

There is a lot of speculation in the news at the moment about what will happen in September. We are still waiting for the government's guidance on how schools can be opened safely for all children to return and I will write to you with more information as soon as we know more.

If school is to open as usual, children in Years 1 to 6 will return to school on Thursday 3<sup>rd</sup> September as planned. Reception and Nursery children will have their usual phased starts at school.

# How you can support your child

Please do all that you can during the rest of this term and over the summer to **support your child's learning**. Remember – paper packs of work can be collected from school for your child to complete and online learning is uploaded to our website every Monday morning. The most **important thing you can do is for your child to read with you every day** and for you to talk about what you have read with them.

I understand that completing home learning can be challenging for families for many different reasons but **please do everything that you can to help your child and stop them from falling too far behind**. The teachers are happy and able to help you in any way that they can – email them at the year group email addresses to request support or to request another phone call.

We will be sending out some extra resources that can be used to all families – these will include key Maths and English skills that your child should learn and practise as much as possible.
