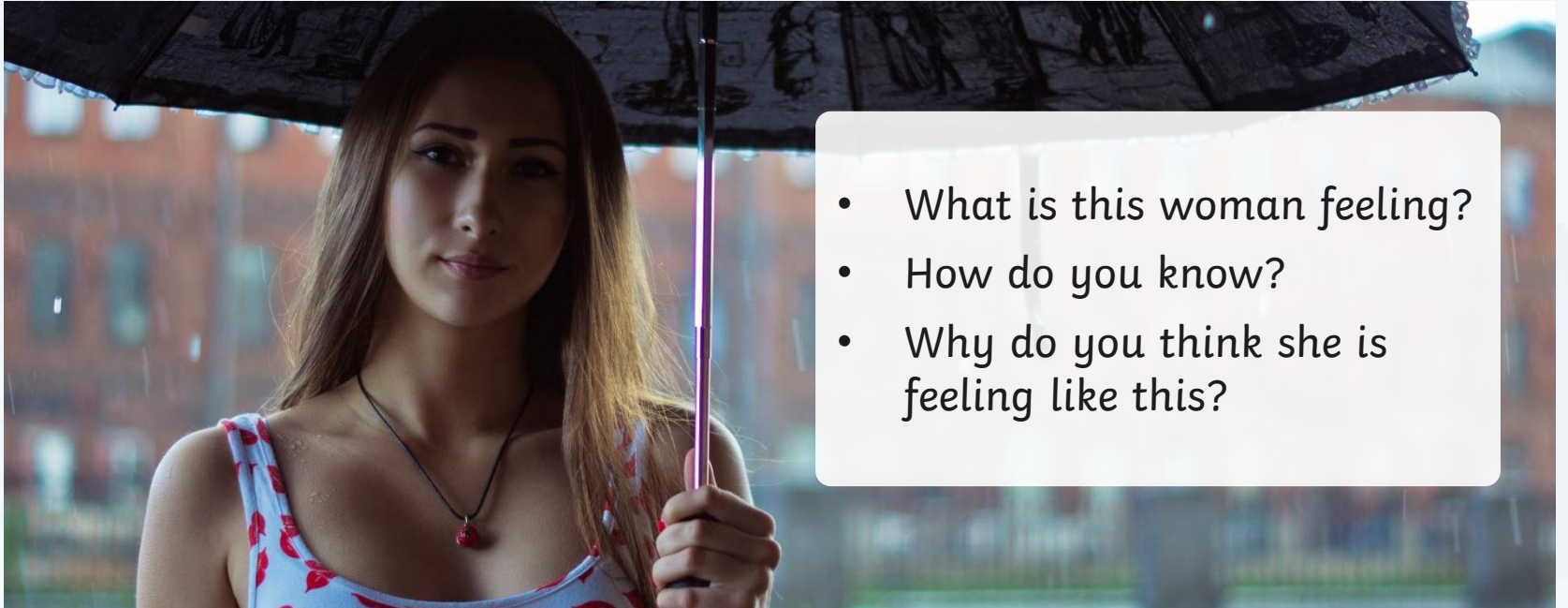

Character Development

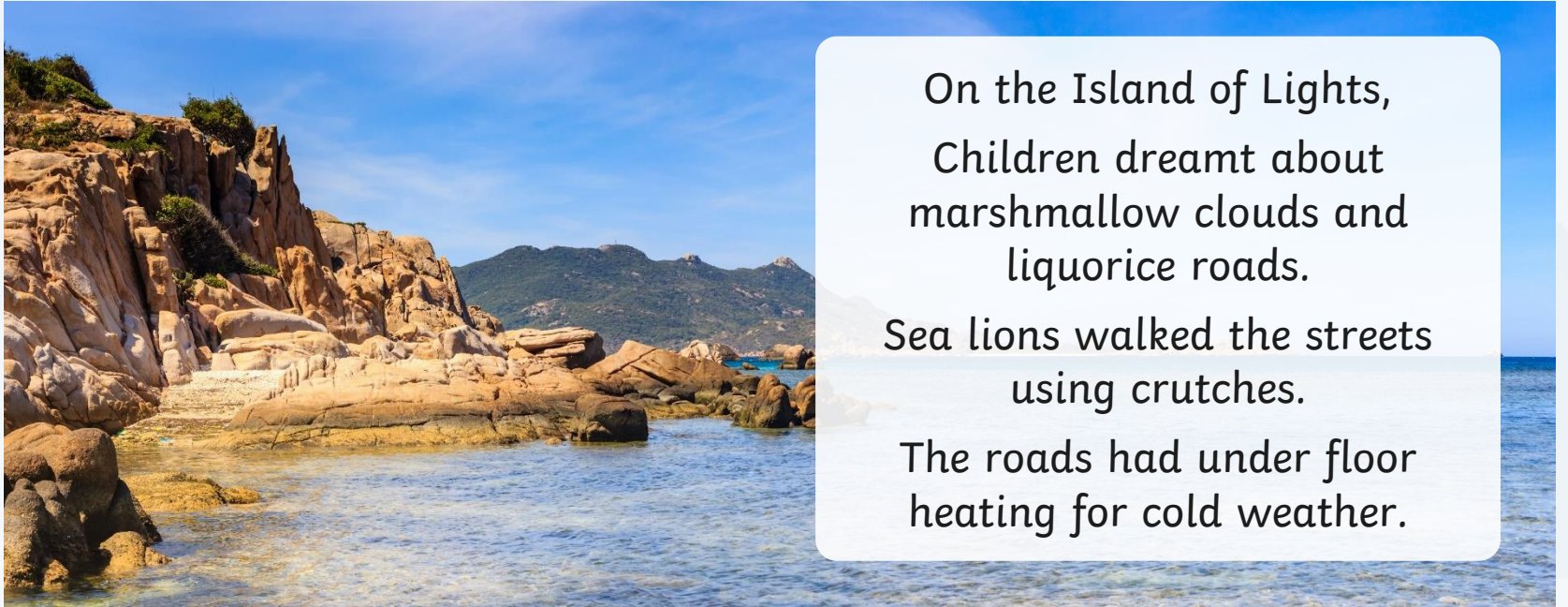


- What is this woman feeling?

liquorice roads.

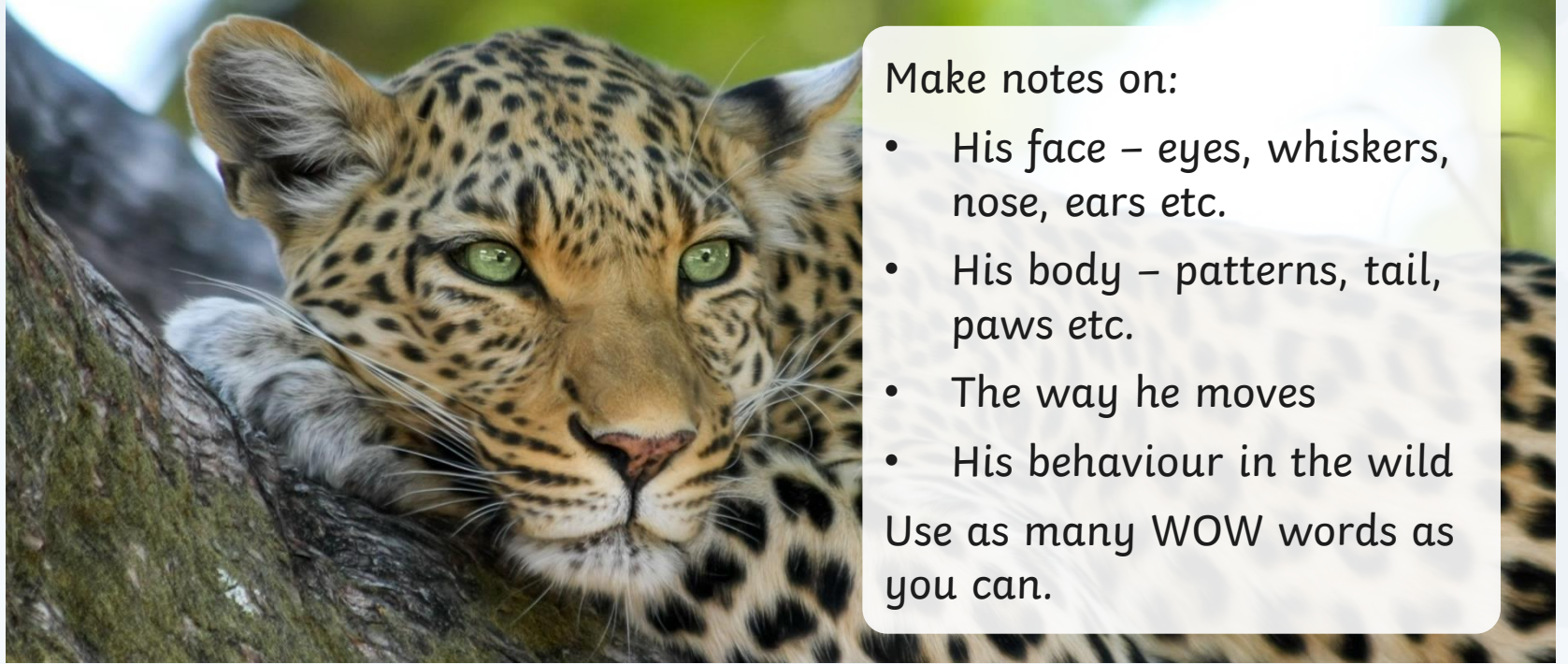
Sea lions walked the streets

Predict What Happens Next

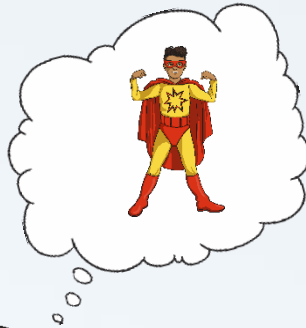
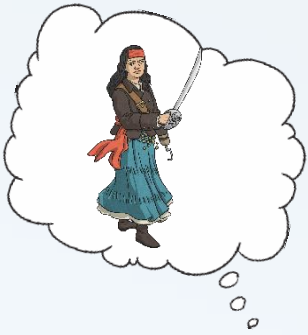


Laura goes on a hiking trip to see the local waterfalls. As she reaches the top of an edge, she takes in the view, but feels dizzy looking down from above.
