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 <p>Understanding the world Oak Academy</p>	<p><u>To understand the difference between hot and cold.</u></p> <p>In this lesson we will be thinking about places and things that are hot and cold. How do we know if something is hot? Is it safe to touch? There a lovely story and a sorting activity that will help you to group things that are hot and cold. Did you get them all right? We also look at how the weather changes at different times of the year and talk in detail about how some of the changes that happen in winter. Finally, there is an experiment that you can join in with that challenges you to find the quickest way to melt ice cubes? Which way do you think is best?
