Tasks 1, 2, 3, 4 and 5 are planned to be done in order.</p> <p>Task 1 – Compare capacities using $<$, $>$ and $=$</p> <p>Task 2 – Measure volume and capacity in ml.</p> <p>Task 3 – Measure volume and capacity in l.</p> <p>Task 4 – Read the temperature using a scale.</p> <p>Task 5 – Complete the arithmetic paper.</p> <p>Arithmetic – Don't forget to log in and practise your arithmetic skills on Numbots and Times Table Rock Stars.</p>	<p>This week will be the first week we start looking at the book Fantastic Mr Fox. Please follow the tasks in order to help with the learning journey.</p> <p><u>Task 1</u> Have a read of the descriptions of the characters from the book. Can you predict if you think the character is a good character or a bad character and give a reason for why you think that.</p> <p><u>Task 2</u> Read Chapter 1 and 2 with your child but DO NOT show them the pictures.</p> <p><u>Task 3</u> Answer the questions using what you know so far.</p> <p><u>Task 4</u> Use what you have read so far to draw illustrations of the characters Boggis, Bunce and Bean.</p> <p><u>Task 5</u> Read Chapter 3, Can you make a prediction on what you think is going to happen next?</p>
Weekly Writing Tasks	Weekly Spelling and Grammar Tasks
<p>This week we will be building towards writing our own report on The Great Fire of London. There are only 3 tasks as we think that writing the will take a long time! Please use the example and the checklist to help you.</p> <p><u>Task 1</u> Today we'd like you to think carefully about the layout of your report and your title and sub-titles. Think and choose carefully.</p> <p><u>Task 2</u> Now you need to plan your report. Use your prior knowledge and the information that you have gathered to add your facts and information under the correct heading. You don't need to write in full sentences at this point.</p>	<p><u>Spellings</u> Regular practise of the 6 spelling words using the strategy: Look, say, cover, write, check. <i>This week's words are: people plant poor pretty prove should</i></p> <p><u>Task 1</u> Use this week's spelling words to correct the jumbled spellings.</p> <p><u>Task 2</u> Practise your spellings using the blue vowels strategy.</p> <p><u>Task 3</u> Can you find the spelling words in the word search?</p> <p><u>Grammar – Compound Words</u></p> <p><u>Task 1</u> Match the words to make compound words.</p> <p><u>Task 2</u> Work out the missing compound words. .</p> <p><u>Task 3</u> Work out the compound words.</p>
