Year 1 Home Learning Project - 'Seasons and Senses'

This half term, we are journeying through the four seasons and the five human senses.

Here are some activity ideas for you to complete at home...



- Harvest. Think about the Autumn Harvest Festival. What might you cook at home, using fruit and/or vegetables? Can you write some instructions for how you made it? How did it smell/taste?

- **Autumn walk**. Enjoy a 'senses stroll', thinking about what you can hear, see, feel and smell. Can you draw a picture of the things you found? Can you write some sentences, remembering your capital letters, finger spaces and full stops?

- **Leaf rubbings**. How many different coloured leaves can you collect? Using some plain paper and wax crayons/pastels, make some leaf rubbings. Can you create a pattern by making rubbings of small leaves in sequence?



- Weather diary. Keep a seven-day weather diary. Can you draw and label the weather for each day? Which was the most/least frequent weather type?

- Four trees. Draw/paint/collage a tree for each of the four seasons. Can you write a sentence describing each tree?

- DIY musical instrument.

Design and create a musical instrument using boxes and elastic bands or cardboard tubes and rice/pasta.

- Blindfold test. Complete a blindfolded taste/smell/touch test. How many different adjectives can you use to describe what you tasted/felt/smelt? Which was your favourite/least favourite? Why?
- **Signs of the seasons.** Create a poster for each of the four seasons, including drawings and labels showing the signs of each season.

- Favourite things. Ask your family and friends about their favourite things to eat/smell/listen to. Can you draw the results?

- **Seasonal outfits**. Draw and label an outfit, suitable for each season. Can you write some 'I would wear...' sentences?

Writing your numbers 0-20 correctly.
