

# Learning for children with an EHCP

Over the past few weeks we have covered different statements from the children's skills ladders. For the last week we wanted to make sure you had chance to recap any learning you have done but to also have work to continue with (if you wanted to do) during the holidays.

For each subject there will be a list of statements that we will all be aiming for the children to achieve but please remember all children will achieve these at a different pace to others. Teachers will also be working on these when the children return to school so please do not feel pressure to cover all statements before returning.

## Maths

- Add one more / take one away from a group of objects and say how many there are now.
- Identify the missing numbers to 20.
- Sort 2D shapes into groups and name them.
- Tell you what is one more / one less than a given number.

## Writing

- Write most of the initial letters correctly (20)
- Hold a simple sentence that I have rehearsed in my head and try to write it down.
- Say a phrase or short sentence I want to write out loud.
- Correctly use my knowledge of letter sounds to write words containing up to 4 sounds.

## Reading

- Read 3 letter words by blending the sounds.
- Simply retell a story.
- Say or sign 40 + sounds when I see them.
- Read some of the common exception words.
- Retell some of the story I have just been reading.
