

Year 1 Home Learning Project - 'Fairy Tales'

This half term, we are enjoying exploring fairy tales. Here are some activity ideas for you to complete at home...



- **Bake gingerbread people.** How many buttons will you give them? Can you write the instructions for how you made your people?



- **Porridge tasting.** Cook up some delicious porridge. Try using different flavours. What do they taste like? Which flavour was your favourite? Why?

- **Design a new fairy tale character.** What will their name be? Will they have a special power? Where might they live? Can you write a label or some sentences about your new character? Can you create a story for your new character?

- **Design and create a setting.** You might want to draw it, paint it or make it inside an old shoebox. You might choose to make a forest, a castle, an underwater world, a volcano or something else!



- **Dress up as a fairy tale character.** Can you put on a show for your family or friends? Can you retell your favourite fairy tale?

- **Build some houses.**

Can you build a model house that wouldn't be able to be blown down by The Big Bad Wolf??

- **Grow a beanstalk.**

All you need is a cup, a runner bean and some cotton wool/compost. Remember to water each day!



- Watch or listen to some fairy tales on YouTube.

- Snuggle up and watch a fairy tale film together!
