

Science Week Beginning 5th May Plants



Usually at this time in Year 2, we get hands-on with planting to discover what plants need to grow and survive and what the main parts of a plant are. We understand that not everyone has an outdoor space or garden or access to a range of plants, so we're moving our 'plants' topic online!

If you do have access to seeds or plants that are already around you, see the next page for some activity ideas.

If you are able to get outside, or have some seeds and soil at home, here are some activities you could do. We'd love to see some pictures

Find a sunny windowsill and plant some seeds. Remember to give it regular water and be patient. It may take a few days, or sometimes weeks for the seed to germinate. (Go back to BBC Bitesize to see how to plant a seed).

You don't always need a pot! If you have kitchen roll, or cotton wool, you can plant some seeds directly onto this. For example, this can be done with cress. You can watch a video of some seeds germinating here
