Remember to count in groups of instead on single quantities.</p> <p>Task 3 Test your knowledge of multiplication by solving these problems!</p> <p>Task 4 Spend 30 minutes on Numbots. It would be really useful if you focused on multiplication.</p> <p>Task 5 Spend 30 minutes practising your times tables skills on TTRockstars.
