### Number Activities:


- Practise counting up to 5

# Share a story with your story

 After you have read the same story a few times ask questions about the story as you read with your child e.g.

What did the character say? What happened at the beginning of the story... middle...?

What might happen at the end of the story? What do you like about the story?

Retell a familiar story

Share a familiar story with your child and over the weeks see if your child can repeat some of the story with you. Possibly if there are repeated sentences such as...Run run as fast as you can you can't catch me I'm the gingerbread man.

Drawing circles and lines

Practice drawing lines and circles through different media such as felt tips, sand, chalk, foam
