Adverbs are fantastic words we use to make our writing more exciting to read.

Adverbs

Adverbs describe the verb – Can you identify the verbs in these sentences

Sarah looked at the painting on the wall.

Snoopy the dog slept on the sofa.

Last week I fell off my swing.

An adverb can be placed either in front of or behind the verb e.g. Snoopy slept peacefully on the sofa or Snoopy peacefully slept on the sofa




