School Closure from Tuesday 5th January

Following the government announcement this evening, all schools in England will be closing to staff and children with immediate effect. This means that from tomorrow (Tuesday 5th January), Uplands Manor Primary School will be closed until at least February half term.

Home Learning Provision and Expectation

Following the announcement, all year groups will be asked to complete their learning at home. Please access the work on our website tomorrow at <u>Uplands Manor Primary School</u> - <u>Work for children not in school</u>. Work will then be set on Google Classrooms from Wednesday 6th January in the same way as when year group bubbles have had to close. All children will receive a phone call from their teacher in the next couple of days to make sure that they can access the learning and to offer any support.

Key worker and Vulnerable Children Provision

As we did during the first lockdown in March 2020, we will be providing onsite provision for certain children. Due to the late timing of tonight's announcement, this will have to be **from Wednesday 6th January** as there is no time to sort out provision in time for tomorrow. This is not ideal but unfortunately we have no other option. This means you will have to keep your child at home tomorrow while our provision is set up.

Vulnerable children – our pastoral team will be contacting parents of these children tomorrow to speak to you about accessing a school place during the lockdown. School Opening for specific groups of children identified by the government.

Please bear in mind we must try to keep pupil numbers in school to a minimum to help slow the spread of transmission in our community and to keep staff as well as families as safe as possible. Please therefore only request a place if it is needed.
