We are a flexible nursery. We can do 5 mornings or 5 afternoons. We also can do 2 and a half days if you prefer. We also offer up to 30 hour provision. Morning sessions are 8.50am till 11.50am. Doors open at 8.45am and close at 8.55am.

Afternoon sessions are 12:20pm till 3.20pm.. Doors will close at 3.25pm.
